**Community Leaders Throughout Michigan Join with  
Healthy and Productive Michigan: Thursday and Friday Press Conferences**

**Lansing, MI:** It is being announced today that 8 Michigan regions will be hosting “Community Voices” Press Conferences on Thursday, October 25 and Friday, October 26, 2018.

From Marquette to Muskegon to Monroe, a far-reaching coalition of Michigan citizens, including Impacted Families, Medical Professionals, Business Leaders, School Superintendents, Clergy, Elected Officials, Recovering Drug Addicts, Mental Health Professionals and others will join to speak regarding the proposed legalization of recreational marijuana in Michigan.

The President of Healthy and Productive Michigan, Scott Greenlee said, *“It is important for us to give a place for those who have been impacted by this on a personal level a chance to speak up. We want the media and public at large to garner a better understanding of what people in their professional and personal space see, and to be able to explain why they are concerned.”*

In addition to individuals, organizations taking part in these events include: the Michigan State Medical Society, DTE Energy, Faith Based Leaders, Michigan Chamber of Commerce, Law Enforcement, Families Against Narcotics (FAN), the Michigan Treatment Court Professionals (MATCP), Michigan Catholic Conference, Educational Professionals and others.

Healthy and Productive Spokesperson and former Senate Majority Leader Randy Richardville is Hosting a Press Conference in Monroe. He stated, *“We are looking to tell the story in Southeast Michigan.
