Detroit News Editorial Board Encourages a NO VOTE on Proposal 18.1

Lansing, MI: One of Detroit's most significant news sources, and one of the two largest papers serving the State of Michigan, has come out with an <u>official Editorial statement</u> encouraging a NO vote on Proposal 18.1, the initiative that would legalize recreational marijuana.

Scott Greenlee, President of Healthy and Productive Michigan said, "This is huge - we are thrilled with this significant "endorsement" and are grateful to the Editorial Board of the Detroit News for the responsible recommendation they are making to the people of Michigan!"

The Editorial states, "The primary problem with this proposal is that it won't do what its name implies: regulate marijuana like alcohol. Prop 1 would leave too much of the marijuana production and distribution network underground, making enforcement of regulatory and tax policies difficult."
