Law Enforcement Sound the Alarm: Legalizing Recreational Marijuana Will Be Devastating to Michigan's Citizens

Lansing, MI: Healthy and Productive Michigan is thrilled at the strong show of support from the statewide Press Conferences hosted by Prosecutors, Law Enforcement, Local Officials and Prevention specialists on Wednesday.

"We could not have asked for a better display of strength," elated HPM President Scott Greenlee said. He continued, *"It is important for us that Michigan voters know that Law Enforcement and Prosecutors - the guardians of our streets and justice system - support this effort to stop the legalization of recreational marijuana."*

Six regional press conferences were held throughout Michigan. Multiple departments were represented from healthcare to substance abuse specialists, to parents, fire departments and faith leaders. But the primary focus was on the Rule of Law leaders.

Chairman of the effort, Cass County Prosecutor Vic Fitz said, *"Police, prosecutors, parents, proprietors, educators, medical professionals and grassroot citizens are standing up to say enough is enough. We want to protect our children and our future. Michigan does not want to become the Midwest marijuana magnet."*

Greenlee continued, *"The advocates of this ballot proposal tell a false narrative. They say that legalizing recreational marijuana will cut down on Law Enforcement's responsibility, make more room in the jails, and save money. They are wrong and Law Enforcement knows it."*

It is on the ballot on Tuesday, November 6 to legalize recreational marijuana in Michigan.
